

Literacy Hot Seating

Miss Davies has been reading us some great stories about the farm, at home I thought you could try 'hot seating'. 'Hot seating' means where you take on a role of a character from a story and you are interviewed (asked questions) about what you've been up to in the story by someone in your house. I thought you could 'hot seat' as the ladybird from the story 'What The Ladybird Heard'. Before you try this activity, listen to Miss Davies reading the story again to remind yourself what happened.

These are examples of questions you could ask the ladybird:

Who are you?

What animals live on the farm?

How did the thieves want to steal the cow?

When did the thieves try to steal the cow?

How did you save the cow?

What else could you ask the ladybird?

Why not try being one of the thieves from the story and be asked some more questions.
